



MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR TYPICAL DRYWALL APPLICATIONS

Note: Consult your local hardware store for proper mounting to other wall materials. Tools required: Phillips and slotted screwdriver and tape measure.

- 1. Place Paper Towel Holder in desired location.
- 2. Turn the paper holder rod counter-clockwise to remove it from the post
- Mark the location of drywall anchor installation. Remove the post from the wall. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, pierce the tip of the anchor into the wall. Do not "push" or drive the anchors into the wall, they are designed to bore into the wall like a screw. Turn clockwise until anchor is flush with the wall.
- 4. Once both sets of anchors are in place, place the post over anchor and insert mounting screws. Turn mounting screws clockwise just until you feel resistance.
- 5. Install the paper holder rod by turning clockwise into the post



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Dust often using a clean, soft, dry and lint-free cloth.
- 2. Blot spills and wipe with a clean, damp cloth immediately.
- 3. We do not recommend the use of chemical cleansers, abrasives or furniture polish on our lacquered finish.
- 4. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connections are tight. Re-tighten if necessary
