TOOLS REQUIRED: Pencil, Drill with an appropriate size bit.

INSTALLING INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Mounting pins are provided for mounting to wood board. Please consult your local hardware store for assistance when mounting on walls made of alternate material.

- 1. Determine the desired mounting location for your house number(s). *you might better draw a reference horizontal line on the wall for aligning the numbers*. Place the house number against the wall and use it as a template marking the locations of mounting pins.
- 2. Use a 1/4 inch diameter drill bit and an appropriate drill to make holes at these marks. Drill each hole for 1" in depth.
- 3. Threading mounting pins into the back of house number. Press the house number into the wall firmly.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Wipe with a soft, dry cloth. To protect the finish, do not use household cleaners or abrasives.
